

ransaxle, Cambiocorsa, Skyhook suspension, Brembo brakes, MSP: the most advanced technologies with the sole aim of enabling you, the driver, to enjoy the power and exuberance of the famous Maserati V8 to the full, and in complete safety.

ENGINE – NO LIMITS TO PERFORMANCE

Maserati's 90-degree V8, 4244 cc engine is compact and light. Its structure design the most advanced racing engines, with dry sump lubrication and an oil pump assembly mounted outside the cylinder block. It features two overhead, chain-driven camshafts per cylinder bank, and four valves per cylinder operated by hydraulic tappets.

Other features include integrated Bosch ME7.3.2 ignition and injection systems and a "Drive-by-Wire" electronically controlled throttle, while the microprocessor control units (ECU) interact with their systems via CAN (Controlled Area Network) line to optimise the efficiency of the engine throughout its operating range.





TRANSAXLE - EXCELLENCE IN EQUILIBRIUM

The gearbox is rear-mounted together with the differential. This ensures a balanced weight distribution between the front and rear axles to optimise traction and acceleration, and deliver agile, highly responsive handling in all conditions – guaranteeing an exhilarating driving experience and exceptional road holding.

CAMBIOCORSA¹⁾ – RACING TECHNOLOGY

Derived from Formula 1 technology, the Cambiocorsa is an electronically operated 6-speed gearbox with electrohydraulic clutch operation, and gear selection controlled by paddles behind the steering wheel.

In both manual and fully automatic mode, the driver has a choice of two gear shift management programmes. «NORMAL» mode ensures maximum comfort for everyday use, while «SPORT» mode delivers faster gear changes.

SKYHOOK¹⁾ – COMFORT AND PERFORMANCE

Developed in association with Mannesmann-Sachs, the 'Skyhook' suspension system uses a host of sensors to continuously monitor the road surface through the movement of the wheels, and instantaneously²⁾ adapts the dampers to guarantee maximum ride comfort in "Normal" mode, or if set in "Sport" mode, it allows the driver to "feel" every ripple in the road – emulating the level and quality of feel and feedback achieved in a real racing car.

SAFETY – ACHIEVING MAXIMUM LEVELS IN ALL SITUATIONS

ACTIVE

- Brembo braking system with light alloy four-piston differentiated-diameter callipers and cross-drilled ventilated discs (330 mm x 32 mm front, 310 mm x 28 mm rear).
- Two-stage brake servo and four-channel Bosch 5.7 ABS anti-lock system.
- EBD electronic braking force distributor.





- MSR System (prevents locking of the rear wheels during change-down, to exploit engine braking).
- Maserati Stability Programme (MSP)³⁾ as standard (integrates the ABS, EBD and ASR traction control).

PASSIVE

- Steel monocoque with supplementary tubular steel structure, complying with the most severe passive safety standards and the latest crash test regulations.
- Front and side airbags.
- Seatbelts with electronically controlled pyrotechnic pretensioners.
- Inertia switch (cuts off the fuel pumps to prevent fire in the event of an impact).

Finally, expert drivers and sports purists can exclude electronic stability control, whilst still leaving the ABS active.

THE MOST EXCITING MASERATI V8







nspired by the famous A6G GranSport designed by Carrozzeria Frua, the Maserati GranSport has a racing heart and provides its driver with all the technology and experience garnered from the Trofeo Maserati championship. An exuberant 400 HPV8 and painstaking attention to aerodynamic efficiency (Cd 0.33) make this model a car capable of delivering a true racing car experience.

RACING SOUL

MASERATI V8, 400 HP, DRY SUMP

Normally aspirated, the 4244 cc V8 produces 400 HP (295 kW) with dry sump lubrication, twin overhead camshafts per cylinder bank, continuous variable valve timing on intake side, and four valves per cylinder, driven by hydraulic tappets.

CAMBIOCORSA ONLY

Derived from Formula 1 technology, the Cambiocorsa is an electronically operated 6-speed gearbox with electrohydraulic clutch operation, and gear selection controlled by paddles behind the steering wheel. Compared to the Coupé version, gear changing in the GranSport is even faster and there is automatic simulation of «heeling and toeing» when dropping down a gear. In «SPORT» mode the set-up becomes harder, allowing the driver to «feel» the road to maximum effect, accompanied by the stirring sound of the V8 engine.

EXTERIOR

The GranSport is distinguished by front and rear spoilers (the rear one can be ordered in carbon-fibre),

Trofeo Maserati races, low profile tyres (235/35 ZR19 at front and 265/30 ZR19 at rear) and chrome tail pipes for the racing exhausts.

INTERIOR

Trimmed in Carbon fibre, Frau leather and Brightex® racing fabric, the interior features a distinctive Maserati clock in the centre of the dashboard, piping strip in personalised colour and push-button ignition.

DRIVING TECHNOLOGY

- Transaxle architecture with gearbox-differential assembly on rear axle.
- Stability and traction control (MSP) which integrates the ABS, ASR, MSR and EBD functions.

- 19-inch wheels with special Pirelli tyres with low slip angle characteristics.
- Brembo braking system with titanium-colour light alloy four-piston differentiated-diameter callipers and large cross-drilled ventilated discs (front 330 mm; rear 310 mm).

THE INTERIOR: ELEGANT AND FUNCTIONAL

The interior reflects the GranSport's personality with all the elegance and comfort of seating for four adults. chrome finishes on the front and rear grilles, 19-inch alloy wheels inspired by those used in the Body-hugging seats, carbon fibre finished centre console, and ergonomic steering wheel with perforated leather and carbon fibre rim – everything is designed to assure the best driving position in a luxurious context.

In or out of town or on the race track, there is nothing like the sheer exhilaration of experiencing the 400 HP of the Maserati V8, and driving it in complete safety, cocooned in carbon fibre, Frau leather and Brightex® racing fabric.

SPORTY IN EVERY DETAIL

MASERATI V8, 400 HP, DRY SUMP

Normally aspirated, the 4244 cc V8 produces 400 HP (295 kW) with dry sump lubrication, twin overhead camshafts per cylinder bank, continuous variable valve timing on intake side, and four valves per cylinder, driven by hydraulic tappets.

CAMBIOCORSA ONLY

Compared to the Coupé version, gear changing in the GranSport is even faster and there is automatic simulation of «heeling and toeing» when dropping down a gear. In «SPORT» mode the set-up becomes harder, allowing the driver to «feel» the road to maximum effect, with the full-throated roar of the V8 in his ears.

EXTERIOR

The GranSport is distinguished by front and rear spoilers (finished in carbon fibre on request), chrome finishes on the front and rear grilles, 19-inch alloy wheels inspired by those used in the Trofeo Maserati races, low profile tyres (235/35 ZR19 at front and 265/30 ZR19 at rear) and chrome tail pipes for the racing exhausts.

INTERIOR

Trimmed in carbon fibre, Frau leather and Brightex® racing fabric, the interior features a distinctive Maserati clock in the centre of the dashboard, piping strip in personalised colour and push-button ignition.





OFFICINE ALFIERI MASERATI – HAUTE COUTURE FOR CARS




