Today, the double "M" stands for "Maybach Manufaktur" – a reference to the superb engineering and painstaking craftsmanship which ensure that the new generation of Maybach will once again intelligently redefine conventions at the top of the automotive market.

The modern Maybach's technical mastery, classic craftsmanship and dedication to individuality combine with the highest attainable levels of comfort and commanding performance to represent the very summit of high-end automobiles. True exclusivity is a worthy goal, but one too seldom met by today's coachbuilders. The new Maybach is a work of art, a masterpiece that embraces its heritage as a pinnacle of automotive achievement and moves the meaning of absolute personal luxury forward into an inspired new era.



Maybach 57

The Maybach 57 is an automobile oriented around the act of driving. Its remarkable powerplant – a 543-horsepower 5.5-liter twin-turbocharged V-12 – catapults the Maybach 57 from zero to 60 in just 5.2 seconds in a surprisingly smooth and refined manner. Advanced Airmatic Dual Control suspension with the adaptive damping of ADS II delivers exquisite response and control to the 57's ride and cornering. And Sensotronic Brake Control – nothing short of a revolution in automotive braking – brings computer-controlled electro-hydraulic stopping power to the Maybach, and is further enhanced by a pair of 4-piston calipers at each front brake.

The pleasures of traveling well, however, are not reserved exclusively for the Maybach driver. Every passenger is treated to true digital surround sound from a 600 watt, 21-speaker Bose sound system, while those in the back seats can watch DVD movies and other video programs from two 9.5 inch flat screen color monitors. In any season, the Maybach climate control system can cool or warm the interior in four individual zones. And the rear center console provides a refrigerator as well as special holders for champagne flutes.



Maybach 62

The long-wheelbase Maybach 62 is simply the world's most refined and advanced form of personal transport. Taking full advantage of more than five feet of legroom between the front and rear seats, the two first-class aircraft style rear seats feature the ultimate in luxury, functionality and electrically-adjustable range of motion. Each Grand Nappa leather-covered, orthopedically designed seat offers 43-degrees of recline with telescoping leg support and a footrest to fully support the occupant's whole body in unprecedented comfort. Such a refreshing degree of absolute relaxation and traveling comfort had heretofore been the private domain of passengers on the finest business jets.

The electro-transparent roof is another automotive first being introduced in the Maybach 62. Available as an option, this variable transparency glass roof is embedded with liquid crystals that, at your electric command, darken to filter daylight allowing you to relax beneath a semi-transparent glass dome. Or, in accordance with your mood, you can flood the rear compartment of your Maybach with daylight and enjoy a transparent view of the scenery. After dark, this roof offers adjustable ambient lighting as well. Capable of breathtaking performance on any number of levels, the Maybach 62 pays attention to its passengers in ways that were unimaginable – or at least unimagined – until now.



Materials

The finest-quality leather and wood veneers envelop the luxurious Maybach cabin – creating a net impression more akin to an elegant drawing room than automotive interior. 100 wood trim pieces and up to 210 leather-upholstered components are handcrafted and selected for individual customer specifications. The wood trim is available in rare and circular-patterned amboyna, a distinctive, reddish-brown burl walnut and straight-grained European cherry with complementary black lacquer accents. The leather upholstery, including Grand Nappa and nubuck, represent the finest and most exclusive natural hides available.

Within the uniquely spacious Maybach cabin, the highest expressions of the craftsman's art celebrate your senses. A Maybach interior is a commission of its owner's specific desires using rare, hand-selected leather and wood. It takes 34 days alone to prepare the 100 wood-trim sections for a single vehicle, with each piece being matched by a specialist in an effort to achieve perfection in grain and color. Note the 3-tiered wood trim that extends across the dashboard and each door. These exquisite trim pieces are each composed of 63 separate layers of veneer, aluminum and wood, each applied by hand.

Ensuring the finest private accommodations possible is the Maybach way. This is why each passenger gets not one, but two reading lights to eliminate distracting shadows. It's why the refrigerator within the rear center console is designed to stay cool for up to two hours without power after the engine is shut off. And it's the reason that a Maybach comes with several jewelry and storage compartments, plus a wood and leather rear seat tray table standard for each passenger. In the world of Maybach, every detail is vital, and every convenience is a necessity.
